### Minutes and Resolution of the BoS dated, 02.08.2023, DATS, CUJ

All external experts attended the BoS meeting 03.08.2023 online. Among internal members all were present except Prof. H.P.Singh. The Head, DATS, on behalf of the department and CUJ had extended her special thanks to all external members for their valuable comments and suggestions on the first draft of the proposed syllabus NEP UG Anthropology Program.

External experts made a few essential enquiries on the 'Entry' and 'Exit' requirements of students. External Experts comments on the proposed draft of the syllabus of NEP UG Anthropology Program are as follows:

- 1. Dr. Prasann Patra suggested for beginning the program with a course for all that include students join the program from other than Anthropology disciplinary background. Therefore, he said that one of the courses in the first Semester may be "Introduction to Anthropology".
- 2. Dr. Patra, Dr. Mithun Das and Dr. Alok Gupta discussed upon the matter of Bridge course for the students who would like to exit after one year by completing requirements for the certificate.
- 3. Further, experts deliberated upon the title of the Diploma and Degree after completion of the Anthropology Program at the exit of 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Semesters?
- 4. Dr. Patra observed that the first, second and third semesters in the draft syllabus distributed. 'Major' courses as per following ratio. Credit distribution of Prehistory: Physical: Social: Common are as 13: 3: 3: 3. He advised for reorganising this. Dr. Das endorses it.
- 5. Dr. Patra suggested that all courses must have a practical component.
- 6. Dr. Patra felts that the program may not need 2 credit internship programs but if required that may be included in the eighth Semester.
- 7. Dr. Patra suggested to restructure titles and syllabus of the following papers proposed:

- 8. Experts suggested placing courses like 'Fieldwork & Report writing' and 'Dissertation' in the semesters in which students will be able to utilize summer break for fieldworks. The paper on the Fieldwork & Report writing is already placed in the even semester. But the dissertation paper won't get the benefit of the summer break because the examination of even semesters normally over before summer break.
- 9. Physical Anthropology Practical course have to be included as per suggestion of experts.
- 10. Theories of Anthropology may be offered in the Unit IV.
- has suggested 11. Prof. Nandini Sahu appreciated the contents of the Minor papers. She requested to propose BA Major for Folklore to be introduced.
