The distance between these two universities 2 hours journey by road.

The Department of Tribal Studies (DTS), Central University of Jharkhand and the Department of Anthropology, Sidhu Kanu Birsa University (SKBU), Purulia, West Bengal as per recommendation of 3rd Board of Studies, of DTS, 4th School Board and 20th Academic Council approvals of Central University of Jharkhand may enter in a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for Teaching collaboration.

The DTS has faculty members to offer all papers of Anthropology excluding Physical Anthropology. The department of Anthropology SKBU has faculty members, who are specialized in the area Physical Anthropology. Both of them grew as per their own potential. SKBU may extend the expertise of teaching of Physical Anthropology by taking classes and at present online being a department having laboratory facilities. Matters related to conducting examinations and sessional tests on those papers will be looked after by DTS, CUJ. This is with reference to the unavailability of MOOC courses, invariably beneficial for the academic growth of students of Anthropology of DTS, CUJ in its all domain of knowledge. The DTS, CUJ will offer specialization in the post-graduation as per the available expertise in the department. The aim and objectives of this collaboration is pivoted on academic interests and to share potentials of teaching for academic excellence. Both the



On 21st December 2021, subsequently, to carry forward the work the Head in Charge of DTS conducted a departmental meeting and discuss the matter.

On 4th January 2022, on the basis of the previous meeting, the Faculty members of the DTS had submitted their proposed list of papers to the Head DTS.

On 4th January, Head of DTS submitted the list of GE to the IQAC cell. The List of proposed papers was submitted to the IQAC Director in the meeting was called on by Dean Academic Affairs and Director, IQAC Cell on the same date.

On 06.01.2022, the Dean, Academic Affairs and Director, IQAC had called on another meeting and told to offer papers from conventional subjects like Political Science, Economics,

History, Sociology and Geography. The Head of DTS had shown her disability to offer papers from these proposed areas and instead of Sociology she had agreed to offer papers from Social Anthropology backgrounds.

On 14th January 2022, as per discussion of the meeting, dated 06.01.2022 and as per direction of Dean Academic Affairs, dated, 14.01.2022 (in the WhatsApp), Head DTS sent another List and titles of three papers (from Anthropology background) to be offered as Generic Electives to the WhatsApp of Dean, Academic Affairs, dated, 14.01.2022, The Head, DTS received the communication from Dean Academic Affairs in Whats App only.

On 17th January 2022, faculty members of DTS, in the online departmental meeting (happened on 17.01.2022 at 4 pm). had expressed their choices and willingness to offer the papers and the list of which was submitted to the Director IQAC cell, dated, 4th January 2022.
