ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

Capacity Building & Personality Development Programme for Under-Graduate & Post-Graduate Female Students is an initiative taken by National Commission for Women (NCW), New Delhi to make UG & PG female students competent, confident, independent and employment ready. Department of Education, Central University of Jharkhand recognizes the importance of females in nation building and is organizing this programme in collaboration with NCW.

This whole day programme will consists of three sessions: Personal Capacity Building, Professional Career Skills and Digital Literacy & Effective Use of Social Media.

Personal Capacity Building: This session would help female students enhance their time management, stress management, and communication skills. The objective of this session is to make female learners engage in effective communication by respecting diversity and embracing good listening skills. It will help them in practicing interpersonal skills for better relations with peers and stakeholders.

Professional Career Skills: This session will focus on identifying career opportunities, building resume and presentation skills and empower women students in exploring career opportunities for themselves considering their innate strengths and weaknesses. It will also help students in preparing an appropriate resume, addressing the necessary gaps for facing interviews and actively and effectively presenting their skill sets thereof.

Digital Literacy and Effective Use of Social Media: This session aims to generate awareness among female students on safe usage of internet and social media platforms. It will raise awareness about cybercrimes among women and benefit them preventing and handling cybercrimes.

After completion of each session, students will take a test comprising of 20 MCQs (Hindi /English) where they will be tested for their understanding of the particular session. All the participants will receive a certificate of participation upon completion of all the three sessions and tests.

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME

1. To make UG & PG female students competent, more confident, independent and employment-ready.
2. To enhance their awareness about the significance of soft skills in professional and inter- personal communications.
3. To enable them to prepare an appropriate resume.
4. To make them competent enough to face job interview confidently.
5. To enable them to effectively use technology to find and evaluate information available on social media useful for their life.
6. To make them aware about the cyber-crimes and safeguards thereto.
