OFFICE ORDER

The Disciplinary Committee constituted vide Letter No CUJ /GA/26/2016/1463, dated 03.08.2023 inquired into the incident took place on 1st August 2023 in front of the Admin Building and submitted its report to the Vice-Chancellor. The report of the Disciplinary Committee was referred to Proctorial Board for suitable recommendation as per CUJ Students Disciplines and Conduct Rules, Clause 4 (Punishment) under Category II Point no. 2 and 4. The Proctorial Board in its meeting held on 24.08.2023 unanimously resolved to take precautionary measures.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor has been pleased to approve the recommendations of the Proctorial Board. The recommendations of the Proctorial Board are as follow;

I. The Students named below:

- (i) Must vacate the hostel by 29.08.2023 with all their belongings. The Hostel Warden and Security officer shall ensure the vacation and shall report to the office of the undersigned.
- (ii) Should not be allowed to take food in mess, meet their friends etc. inside the hostel.
- (iii) Not to be seen within the 500 meters of the hostel premises
- (iv) Should ensure 75 percent attendance in the class.
- (v) The monetary fine should be deposited in the University Finance Section within 15 days of notice as detailed below.
