It is hereby notified to all the concerned students that Conversion Formula from CGPA to Percentage is as follows: -


Conversion Formula from CGPA to Percentage

80+ (CGPA-8.5) x 10	>8.5
70+ (CGPA-7.5) x 10	7.5 to 8.49
60+ (CGPA-6.5) x 10	6.5 to 7.49
55+ (CGPA-5.5) x 5	5.5 to 6.49
50+ (CGPA-4.5) x 5	4.5 to 5.49
45+ (CGPA-4.0) x 10	4.0 to 4.49
35+ (CGPA-3.0) x 10	3.0 to 3.99
30+ (CGPA-2.5) x 10	2.5 to 2.99
25+ (CGPA-2.0) x 10	2.0 to 2.49
15+ (CGPA-1.0) x 10	1.0 to 1.99
0+ (CGPA-0.5) x 15	0.0 to 0.99

Explanatory Note:

1. For example, if a student has obtained a CGPA of 6.00, his percentage is $55 + (6 - 5.50) \times 5 = 55 + 0.50 \times 5 = 55 + 2.50 = 57.50$

2. Similarly, if a student has obtained a CGPA of 4.38, his percentage is $45 + (4.38 - 4.00) \times 10 = 45 + 0.38 \times 10 = 45 + 3.80 = 48.80$
